Free energy efficiency information, advice and resources to help your organisation help others

The Energy Partners Program (EPP) works with organisations across the state to help South Australians manage their energy use and costs.

The program provides resources and information to partner organisations free of charge, or at a subsidised rate, to help their clients or residents understand their energy use and take action to reduce it.

The program can offer information and advice about energy efficiency including:

- how to save energy in the home and minimise energy bills
- energy rebates, concessions and incentives
- renewable energy.

The EPP complements the Government of South Australia's Energy Advisory Service, which offers free independent energy advice to households.

Assistance from the EPP is tailored to the needs of each partner organisation and includes things like:

- providing energy efficiency tools, resources and information
- providing energy efficiency display material for talks and events
- access to home energy auditing toolkits, to help people assess their home energy use
- training and/or talks for staff, volunteers and the community
- signposting to other government services and an online directory of energy-related services
- keeping organisations up to date with energy and sustainability matters via regular newsletters
- facilitating networking with other interested organisations and individuals
- opportunities to participate in community energy capacity building projects.
