GAP Service

What is it?

The GAP Service is a mental health assessment service for youth with developmental disabilities, emotional and behavioural problems.

It has been established for young people between the ages of 8 and 21 years.

How to access the service

Disability Services clients are first seen at the Centre for Disability Health (North East Clinic). This is a specialist service and requires a referral from a general practitioner.

Where the client does not have their own general practitioner to make a referral, the general practitioners of the North East Clinic may see a client in the first instance and assist in the referral process.

What does it offer?

The GAP Service offers short-term mental health assessment from a developmental perspective. It also provides the client, family and service coordinator with practical and user-friendly advice on management. This includes suggesting and linking clients with other community services or agencies to facilitate ongoing and sustainable support.

The service does not offer ongoing care or involvement.
