### Library and Information Service— Disability Collection



The Department for Families and Communities Library and Information Service—Disability Collection maintains information and resources on all aspects of intellectual disability, Autism Spectrum Disorders, adult physical and neurological disabilities and acquired brain injury. The service is freely available to DFC staff and clients, including Disability Services clients, and members of the public.

The Disability Collection includes kits, books, journals, videos, DVDs and CD ROMs covering topics such as:

- ▶ daily living skills
- ▶ sexuality
- ▶ personal hygiene
- ▶ relationships
- ▶ challenging behaviour.

We also have a parent collection that includes children's books about a range of disabilities, sleep problems and toileting; picture books through to adolescent fiction; books for siblings; information for parents and carers; and books without words targeted to adults with disabilities.

### Services Available

#### Access to new material

The Disability Collection produces a quarterly bulletin which lists new books, videos, DVDs and journal articles.

Books, kits, videos and DVDs can be requested for loan and articles can be copied on request.

#### Reference services

The Disability Collection uses its own resources, other collections, online databases and the internet to find information you want.

Requests can be made via phone, fax, email and in person.

Materials will be delivered by mail, email or by courier to our nearest regional office.

#### Internet access and training

The Disability Collection offers free internet access and free training in internet use.

The Disability Collection is open 9am to 5pm weekdays. If you will be needing extra assistance, it is recommended that you contact library staff before your visit.

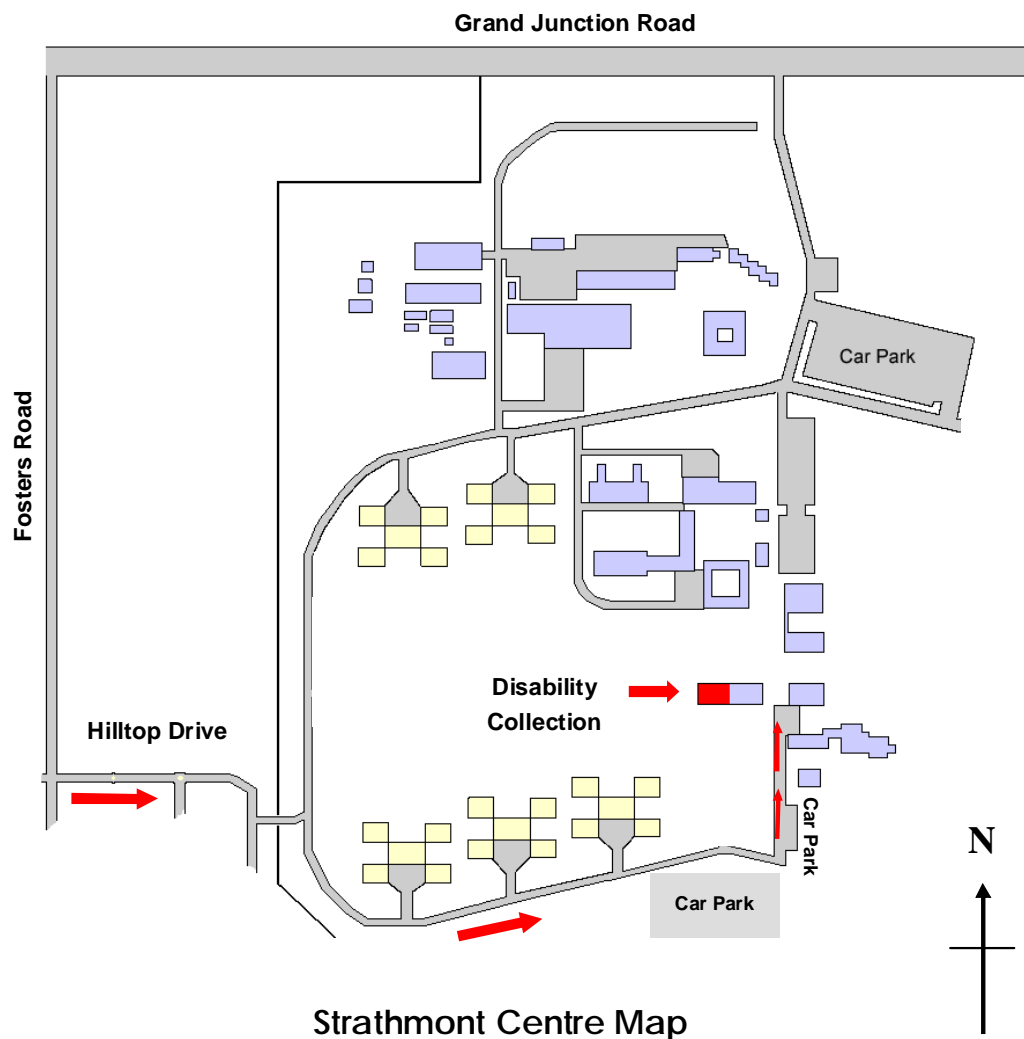
