UNIFORM STANDARDS FOR SUBURBAN TAXIS

SHIRTS	Light blue (or white for Gold Elite drivers) – business style with a collar and either long sleeves or short sleeves.
BADGES	Suburban Taxis badge fixed above left breast pocket or shirt. The badge must be style approved by the CBS and must be embroidered or pinned to the shirt.
EPAULETTES	Optional.
TROUSERS	Navy blue or black – business style. Note: Jeans, tracksuit pants, corduroy pants, work pants or cargo pants cannot be worn.
SKIRTS	Navy blue or black – business style. Note: Denim or corduroy skirts cannot be worn.
SHORTS	Navy blue or black – business style. Note: Denim shorts, tracksuit shorts, corduroy shorts, sport pants or cargo shorts cannot be worn.
TIES	Optional.
JUMPERS	Navy blue, v-neck – long sleeve or sleeveless.
JACKETS	Navy blue. Note: Tracksuit tops / jackets cannot be worn.
SHOES	Black, navy blue or brown to match the uniform – business style or joggers (without stripes). Note: Sandshoes and sandals without heel straps cannot be worn.
SOCKS	Socks must be worn at all times with trousers and shorts
HATS	Plain navy blue or black to match uniform. Plain baseball cap with a Suburban Taxis logo, a logo promoting the State of South Australia or the taxi industry logo. Note: Beanies cannot be worn.

- All trousers, skirts, shorts, jumpers, jackets and hats must match in colour.
- All logos and badges on uniform must be consistent with the CBS livery displayed on the vehicle being driven.

Regulation 85 (1) (b) of the Passenger Transport Regulations 2009 states:-

The driver of a public passenger vehicle must wear a uniform that complies with determined or approved by the Minister. The uniform must be clean, pressed and not have any holes, tears or stains.

A breach of this regulation carries a fine of \$105.00 plus \$60.00 levy fee.
