

## Expanded eID Device Rebate (2025-2027)

The applicant:

- acknowledges and agrees that if they receive a rebate pursuant to this Application that the Application, together with these terms and conditions, will constitute a legally binding agreement between the Minister and them, and they accept and undertake to comply with these terms and conditions.
- acknowledges the rebate is by way of partial reimbursement (up to \$0.475 per device ex GST) for purchase of Non-Colour of Year NLIS accredited eID devices that have been or will be fixed to sheep or farmed goats during 2025, 2026 and/ or 2027 (Purpose) and undertakes that it will only be applied for the Purpose.
- acknowledges that the rebate will be paid within 30 days of acceptance of this offer.
- confirms that the eID tags have been or will be fixed to animals located on the property to which the PIC set out in the Application relates.
- agrees to provide any information, records or reports requested by PIRSA in relation to the rebate to enable PIRSA to make an informed assessment of the ongoing financial position of the applicant, monitor the applicant's compliance with the terms on which the rebate is made and form an assessment as to the overall effectiveness of the rebate.
- undertakes to report to [PIRSA.GrantsEnquiries@sa.gov.au](mailto:PIRSA.GrantsEnquiries@sa.gov.au) following the end of each calendar year (2025, 2026, 2027) in respect of which it has received a rebate for eID tags pursuant to this Application, of the number (if any) of eID tags that have not been affixed to animals and agrees, unless PIRSA advises otherwise, to repay the amount of rebate received in relation any such tags.
- acknowledges that the applicant's obligations pursuant to this Application continue until 31 December 2027, except for reporting and acquittal obligations which will continue to apply until such time as those reports and acquittals are received by PIRSA to PIRSA's satisfaction.
- agrees to provide an acquittal for the grant received and expended at the end of the grant term.
- agrees that where the applicant breaches the terms and conditions of this rebate, the applicant will repay all or part of the rebate as required by PIRSA.
