With respect to my Motor Driving Instructor's licence, I do not work with children (young people under 18 years of age) and I will be seeking a Motor Driving Instructor's licence with a condition "Elected to train adults".

I understand that this means I cannot provide driver training or assessment (if appointed as an Authorised Examiner) to children in my capacity as a Motor Driving Instructor or Authorised Examiner.

I acknowledge that if I am going to provide driver training to children, I must obtain a 'Working with Children Check' in South Australia from the Department of Human Services Screening Unit and provide a copy to the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.

And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of the Oaths Act 1936.
