2. The Transport Concession Card remains the property of Department for Communities and Social Inclusion (DCSI). Lost, stolen or damaged Transport Concession Cards can only be replaced by contacting DCSI. Originals, if later found, must be returned to DCSI.
3. Your Transport Concession Card can only be used by you and is not transferable to others.
4. You must advise DCSI as soon as possible if you change your address, to enable DCSI to reissue your Transport Concession Card.
5. It is your responsibility to ensure you continue to meet the ongoing eligibility requirements for your Transport Concession Card and if you cease to be eligible the Transport Concession Card must be returned to DCSI.
