



Screening for Driver Accreditation Only

Online Screening through the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) is now available.

Before you can hold driver accreditation, you must have a child-related employment screening clearance issued through the Department of Communities and Social Inclusion (DCSI).

Please Note: DCSI Screening clearances are portable between organisations in South Australia and are valid for 3 years.

If you have a current DCSI clearance, you may complete the CONSENT FORM available from the Accreditation and Licensing Centre (ALC) or on the website www.sa.gov.au.

You are required to complete the CONSENT FORM and forward it to the ALC via email at dpti.alconline@sa.gov.au. The ALC will then obtain the required information from DCSI which includes the release of your criminal history.

To apply for a new **Online DCSI Screening**, please complete the information below and forward it to the ALC, at dpti.alconline@sa.gov.au. The ALC will check your email and forward it to DCSI. DCSI will send you two emails - the first email will advise you that DPTI has initiated a screening application for you; the second email will contain your personal account LOGIN details, user-name and password to access the new DCSI online application process for a NCH.

Please note: Payment for the DCSI Screening and 100 point evidence of identity are completed online with DCSI at the same time. Payment can only be made by credit card.
